



## IEEE Reliability Society (RS) Student Achievement Award

**Description:** To recognize outstanding undergraduate and graduate students who are pursuing a career and profession in reliability related discipline.

**Prize:** \$1,000 each awardee with a certificate, up to five winners

**Eligibility:** Full time students pursuing a bachelor or higher degree in STEM fields

**Nomination:** An administrative superior of the nominee (e.g. department head, academic supervisor, or local RS chapter chair) should make and submit the nomination. The nomination package should consist of, (1) a resume of the nominee with concise descriptions of the accomplishments and services of the student, especially those related to RS. (2) a list of courses taken in reliability or related fields, and any leadership and service activities in promoting reliability society or general STEM disciplines, (3) transcripts showing the student is a full time student.

**Submission deadline:** Nov. 30, 2021. All application materials should be sent to Dr. Steven Li at [stevenli777@ieee.org](mailto:stevenli777@ieee.org).

**Basis for Judging:** Evidence of student's interests in reliability and related engineering career pursuit; Technical contributions to the field of reliability engineering; Leadership and services to IEEE RS or local reliability society chapters.
