



IEEE Reliability Society (RS) Scholarship Program

Description: To recognize outstanding undergraduate and graduate students who are pursuing a career and profession in reliability related discipline.

Prize: \$1,000 each awardee with a certificate, up to five winners

Eligibility: Full time students pursuing a bachelor or higher degree in STEM fields

Nomination: An administrative superior of the nominee (e.g. department head, academic supervisor, or local RS chapter chair) should make and submit the nomination. The nomination package should consist of, (1) a resume of the nominee with concise descriptions of the accomplishments and services of the student. (2) a list of courses taken in reliability or related fields, and any leadership and service activities in promoting reliability society or general STEM disciplines, (3) transcripts showing the student is a full time student.

Submission deadline: Nov. 30, 2020. All application materials should be sent to Dr. Steven Li at stevenli777@ieee.org.

Basis for Judging: Evidence of student's interests in reliability and related engineering career pursuit; Technical contributions to the field of reliability engineering; Leadership and services to IEEE RS or local reliability society chapters.
