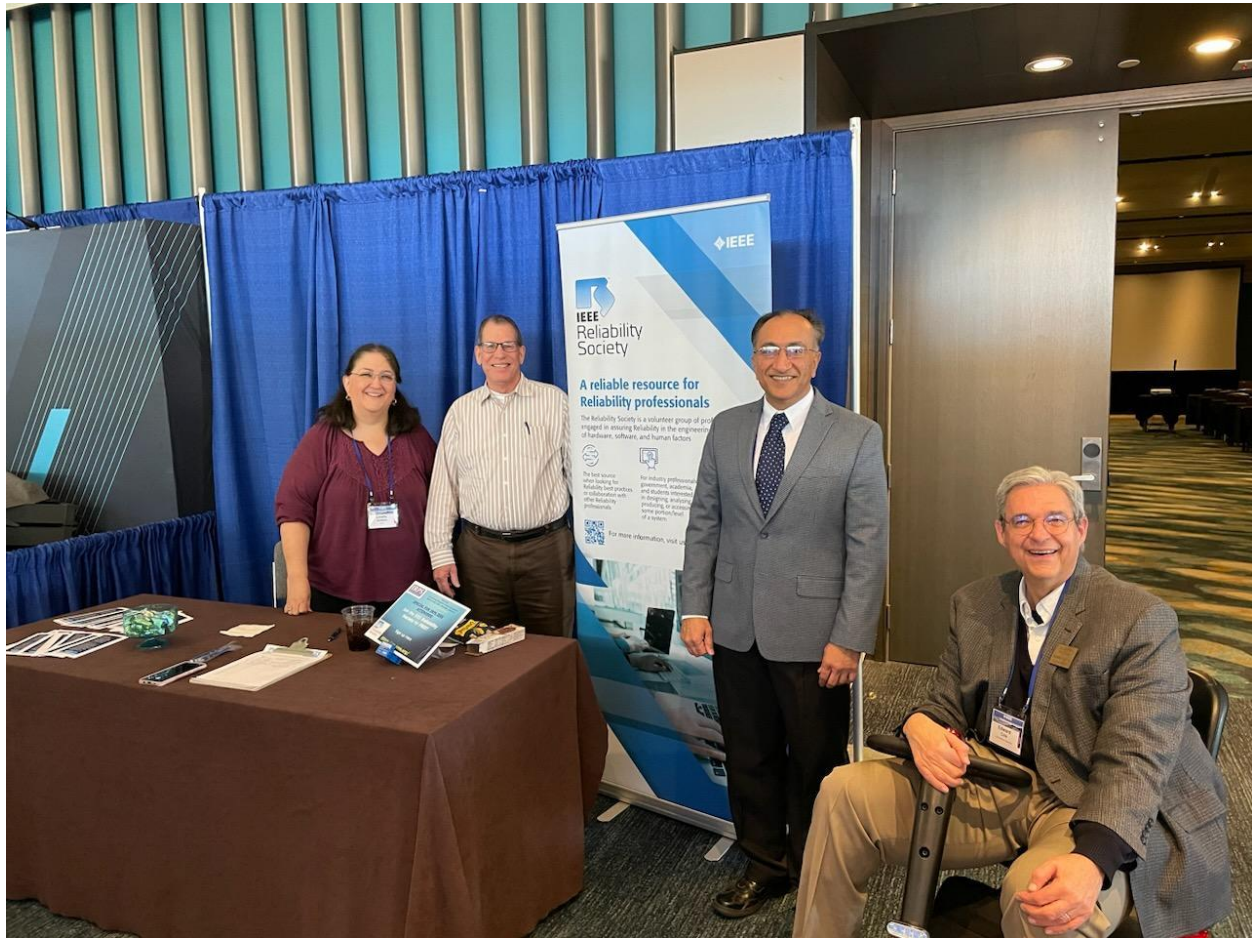


IRPS 2023

I attended the IRPS held in Monterey CA. It is the 61st conference and co-sponsored by the IEEE Reliability and Electron Devices Societies. The 28 Tutorials and 3 Reliability Year-In-Review talks were held on Sunday and Monday. The formal Conference was held on Tuesday-Thursday with 111 Oral Presentations, 81 posters, 4 Keynote presentations by industry leaders. There were about 500 paid registrants, more than 400 in-person and about 100 virtual attendees. The in-person attendance was strong of all sessions including the wrap-up/kick-off session at the end of Thursday. They had record number of 23 corporate patrons and 11 exhibitors.

I set up the RS booth on Monday afternoon. Ed Cole, the RS Representative, assisted me in setting up the booth and in staffing it throughout the week.
